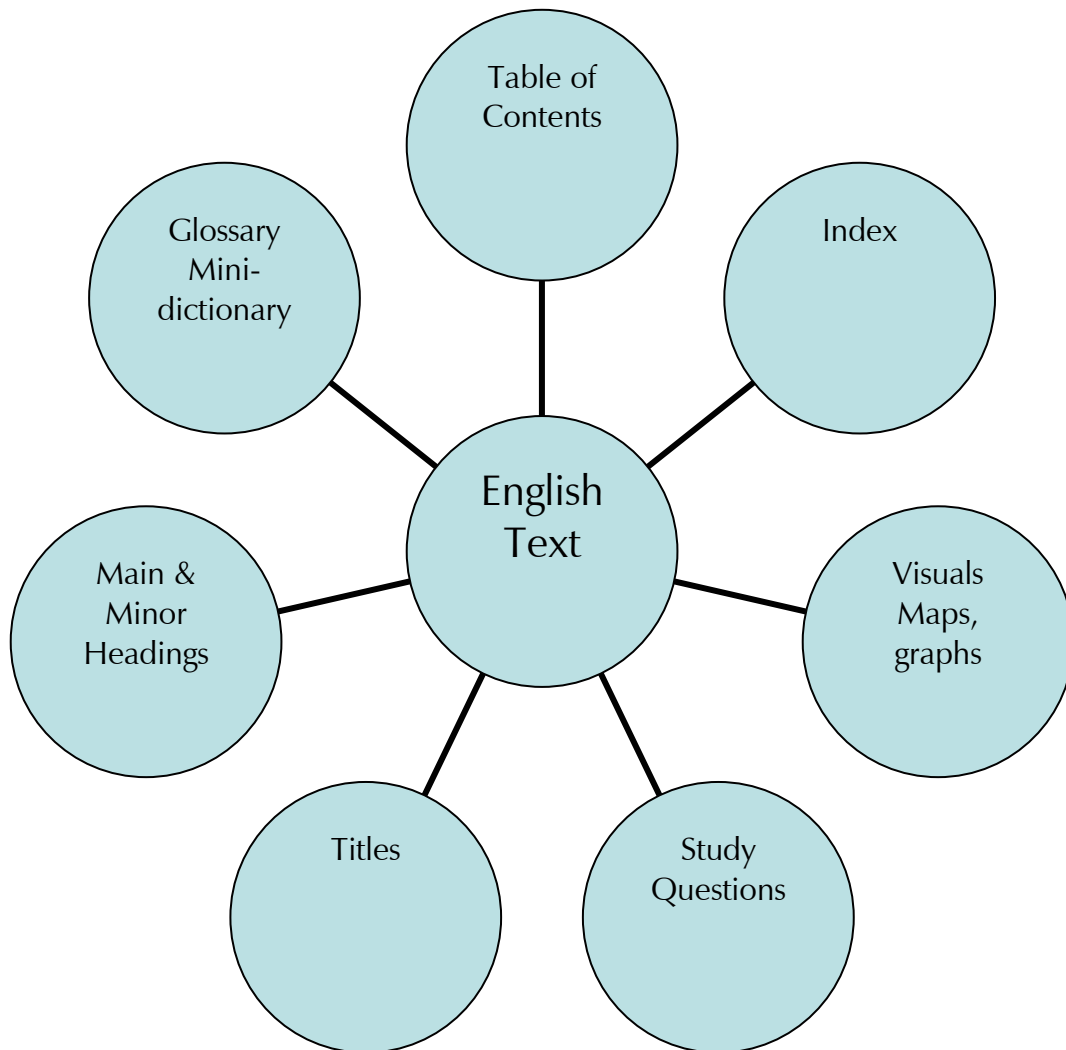

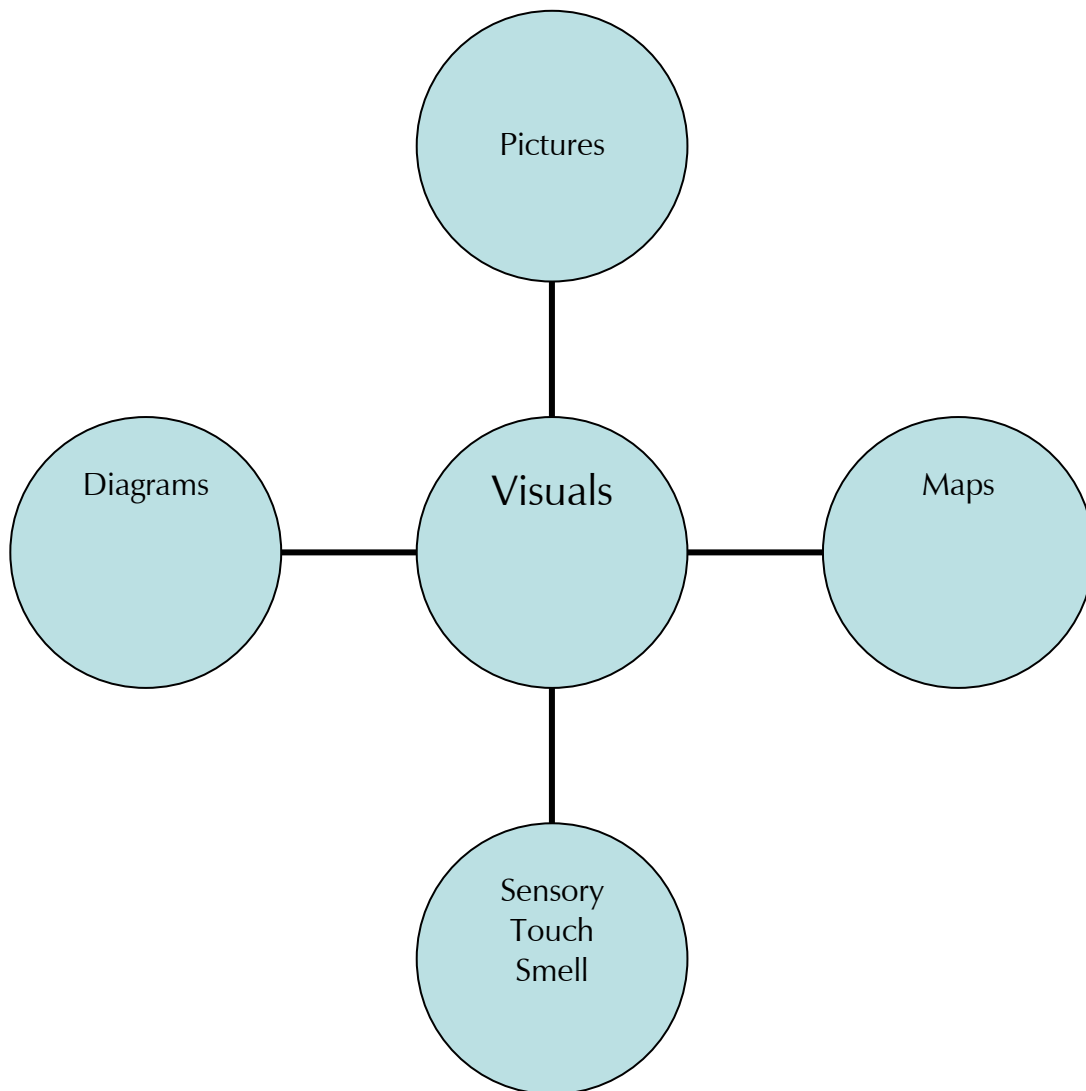

### Visuals

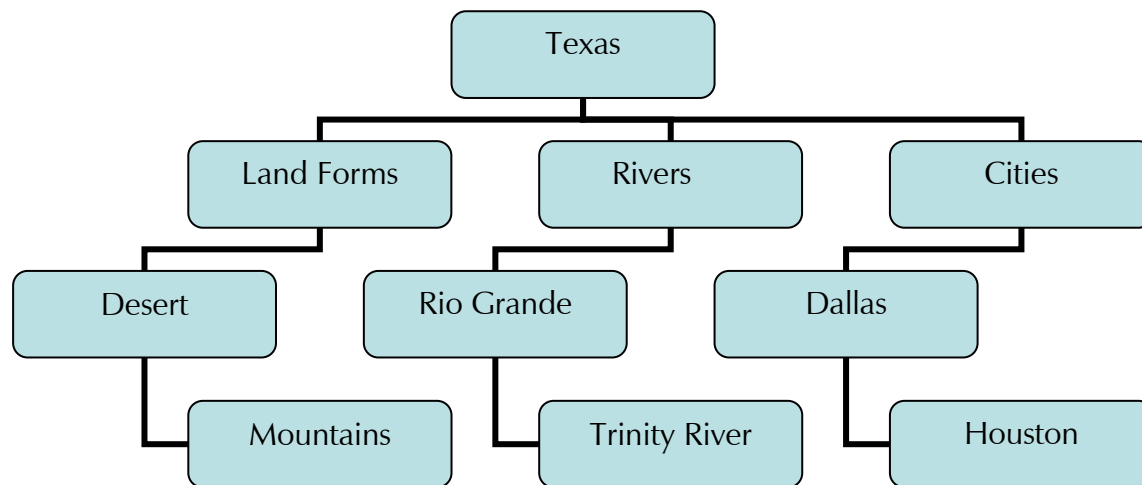
These are the types of visuals seen in an English textbook. Visuals help us comprehend.
